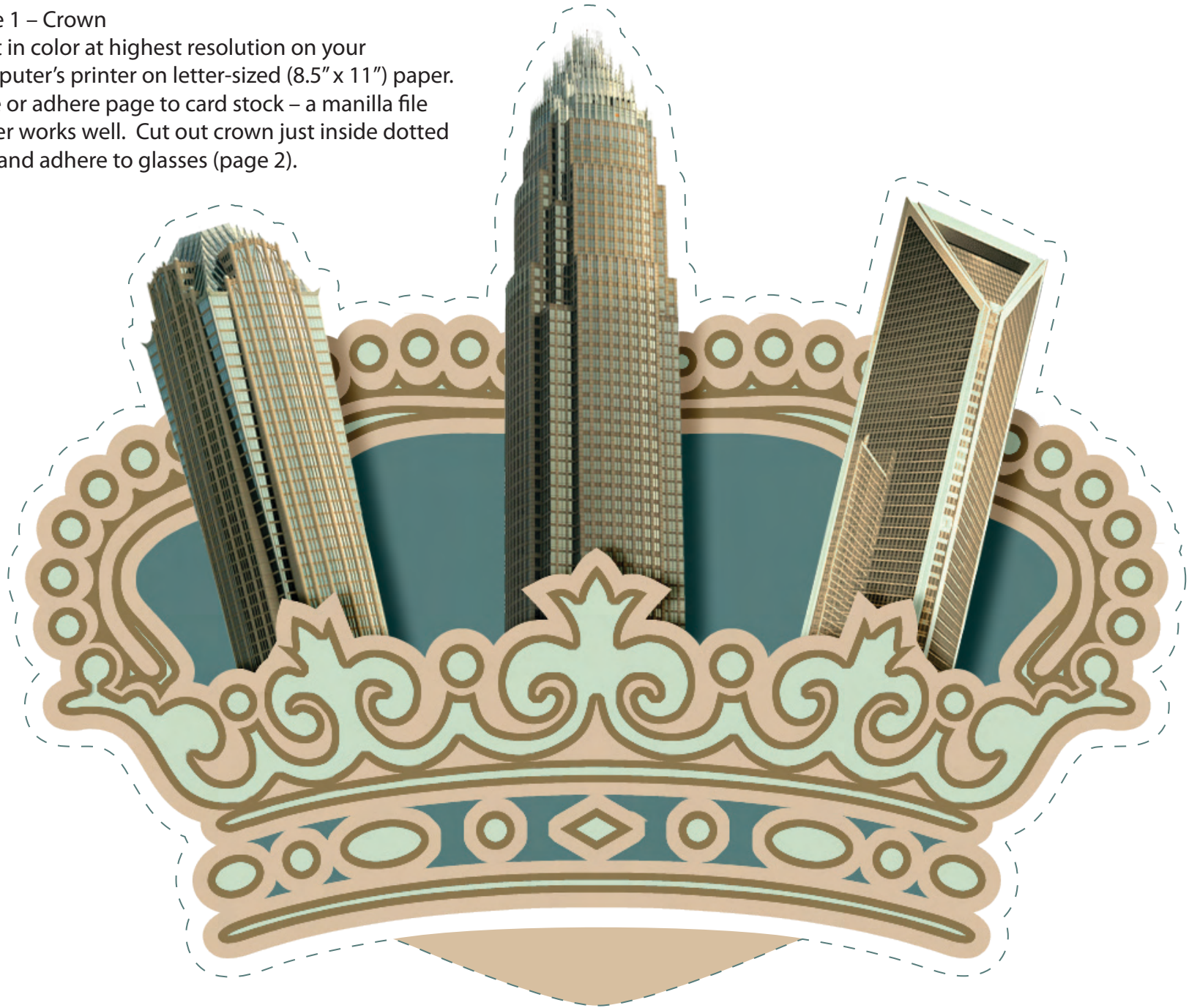


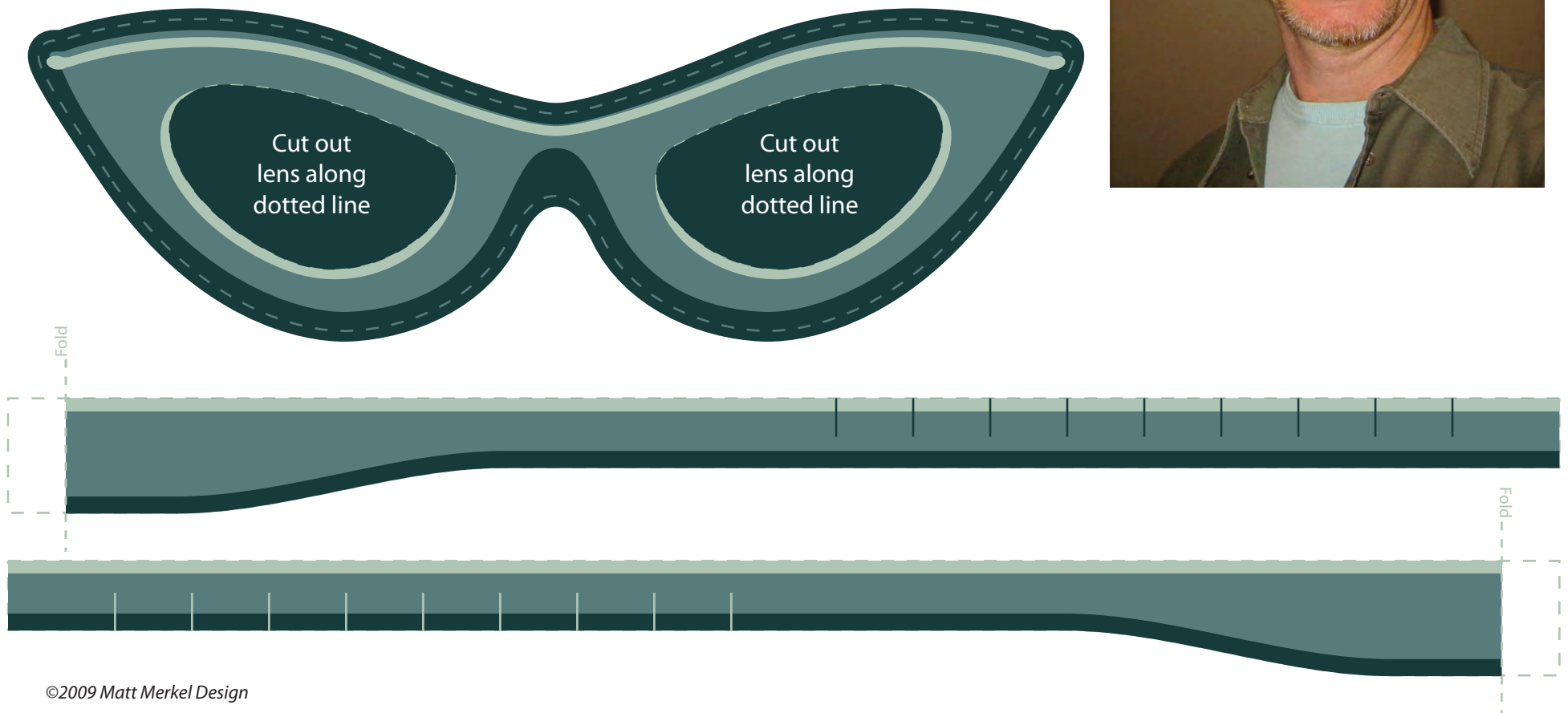
Page 1 – Crown

Print in color at highest resolution on your computer's printer on letter-sized (8.5" x 11") paper. Glue or adhere page to card stock – a manilla file folder works well. Cut out crown just inside dotted line and adhere to glasses (page 2).



Page 2 – Glasses

Print in color at highest resolution on your computer's printer on letter-sized (8.5" x 11") paper. Glue or adhere page to card stock – a manilla file folder works well. Cut out glasses and side arms along dotted lines – fold arms at fold lines. Lay all pieces on table, printed side down. Overlap crown on back of glasses approx. 1/8" so that no gaps appear and crown does not show through lens cut-outs. Use clear tape to affix crown to glasses and trim off excess. Affix folded tabs of side arms to each corner of the back of the glasses. To secure glasses, position on face and wrap side arms around to back of head. Have another person stand behind you and mark where two of the vertical lines on each side arm meet. Cut along both of these lines – do not cut all the way through the arms. Wrap around head and interlock arms at notches – wrap with tape for added security if needed.
